- In compliance with the recommendations for public health, anyone with a cough or fever will not be allowed in the building and should stay home. We will be happy to reschedule your appointment for a later date. Please call 701-254-4521.
- Adults, please only bring yourself to your appointment.
- If you are a parent bringing your child, please only bring the child with the scheduled appointment. Parents will be asked to wear a mask when staying with the child at the operatory.
- Before your appointment, you have the option to stay in your car instead of the waiting room until we're ready to seat you in your personal operatory. Simply call us when you arrive, and we will let you know when we're ready for you.

- Upon entering Linton Dental Center, please wear your own mask; we will take your temperature and you will be asked to sanitize your hands. If you do not have masks we will be able to provide you with cloth masks.
- At the beginning of every appointment, you will be asked to do a mouth rinse which has anti-fungal, anti-bacterial and anti-viral properties
- Additionally, we are requesting you sanitize your hands before reentering the business areas.
- Full payments and co-pays are due at the time of service. We DO NOT accept CASH for the moment. Checks and credit cards will be accepted.
